

24 to 34 weeks pregnant

3D/4D ultrasound

Patient information



You can get great photos between 24 and 34 weeks pregnant.



Using a specially developed technique, a number of **conventional ultrasound images** are taken and saved. Surface dimensions are calculated and **presented as a three-dimensional image**. A static image is a 3D photo. If this is expanded by a dimension, namely time, a moving picture is created by arranging many 3D images in sequence so that they are **viewed as a film in 4D**.

The quality of the images depends greatly on the position of the baby, amount of amniotic fluid, placenta placement and maternal abdominal wall. In approximately 70% of scans, it is possible to get **great photos between 24 and 34 weeks pregnant**.

If it is not possible to get a satisfactory image and the view of the baby is poor, a new appointment will be made at no cost.

I would like to have a **3D/4D ultrasound scan** and am aware that this scan does not diagnose malformations. It does not replace organ screening, which is always recommended between 21 and 24 weeks pregnant.
